#### **Fund Overview**

This annual shareholder report contains important information about The Gabelli International Growth Fund, Inc. (the Fund) for the period of January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024. The International Growth Fund's investment objective is to provide investors with long term capital appreciation. The Fund's investment strategy is to invest at least 65% of its total assets in equity securities of foreign issuers located in at least three countries outside the United States that Gabelli Funds, LLC (the Adviser) believes are likely to have rapid growth in revenues and earnings and potential for above average capital appreciation. The Fund invests in companies that have the potential to grow faster than other companies in their respective equity markets and are priced at attractive valuation levels. 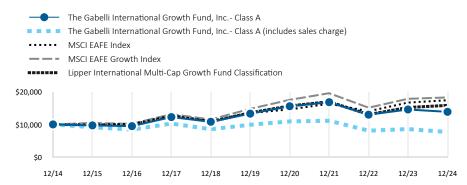
#### How did the Fund perform?

For the fiscal year ended December 31, 2024, the Gabelli International Growth Fund underperformed its broad-based benchmark, MSCI EAFE Index and its comparatives, the Lipper International Multi-Cap Growth Fund Classification and the MSCI EAFE Growth Index. Most overseas developed economies are performing poorly and certainly underperforming the US economy. This has been reflected in voter dissatisfaction with incumbents who lost share of the vote in twelve developed country elections. The underperformance of international equities has reached a level that many investors are questioning investing outside the US as many overseas firms now chose to list in the US.

#### How has the Fund performed over the past 10 years?

The performance chart of the fund class presented reflects a hypothetical \$10,000 investment, assuming the maximum sales charge, compared to a broad-based securities market index and more narrowly based indices reflecting market sectors in which the Fund invests over a 10-year period. The chart uses total return NAV performance and assumes reinvestment of dividends and capital gains distribution. Fund expenses were deducted.

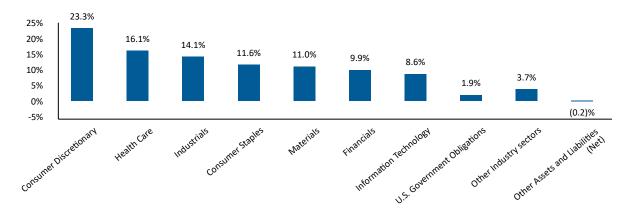
